- AP & Pre-AP classes will be scored on a 5 point grading scale
- Students with the highest GPA will be named valedictorian
- Other requirements are good character, no suspensions, and no NC's on transcripts
- Graduation speakers will be limited to the students with the highest and 2nd highest GPA

Enrollment Information

- Levels of courses will be assigned based on test scores, grades, and teacher recommendations
- Students who did not pass the 8th grade reading test will be required to complete remediation and pass the alternative reading test before receiving their reading proficiency letter.
- Students who did not pass the 8th grade math test may be enrolled in a lower level math course to be counted as elective credit
