ACT TEST DATES

ACT Fee Waiver

*Enrolled in federal free or reduced lunch *Reside in Foster home, ward of the state, or are homeless *Family receives low-income public assistance or lives in federally subsidized public housing *Students can use up to 4 waivers *See Mrs. Chadd to get the Waiver request

Students can receive fee waivers for college entrance exams if you have received an ACT Fee waiver.

What is Financial Aid

- 1. Free Money Scholarships and grant
- 2. Earned Money Work Study or Job
- 3. Borrowed Money Loans

Why is the FAFSA Important?

- Graduation Requirement Opt Out Available
- How you become eligible for aid for which you may qualify
- You must file if you are on OK Promise
- FAFSA is sometimes used for other scholarship opportunities
- The application is how you qualify for grants, loan, and work study

Things to Remember

- Apply early
- Apply early
- File FAFSA ASAP Dec 1st (Maybe)
- Respond promptly to request for information
- Open the mail and check emails on a daily basis
- Make it a family project
- Ask questions

Scholarships

- Mrs. Chadd's Website Scholarship Page
- Sell yourself
- Type all applications
- Turn into or mail to the appropriate place
- Be organized

Transcript Request

- Parchment Exchange
- Mrs. Chadd or Miss Lawson
- Allow 24 hours

Letters of Recommendation

- Prepare personal information about yourself to give to the school official to help them individualize the letter.
- A resume works well.
- Allow plenty of time 1-2 weeks is appropriate
- It is appropriate to follow up a letter of recommendation with a thank you note.
